Audi presents A3 concept in Geneva

- **Attractive concept car as a four-seater notchback sedan**
- **Five-cylinder, 300 kW (408 hp) turbocharged engine with quattro drive**
- **Based on the successor to the Audi A3**

Geneva/Ingolstadt, February 21, 2011 – Audi will present an attractive technological concept car based on the coming generation of the Audi A3 at the 81st International Geneva Motor Show in early March 2011. The four-seater notchback sedan offers a glimpse of the future expansion of the A3 family.

The sporty yet elegant design of the Audi A3 concept integrates the single-frame grille with its tapered upper corners and headlights with the latest generation of LED technology. The low, flowing roof dome and a coupe-like, low C pillar are among the defining features of the side view. The Audi A3 concept is 4.44 meters (*14.57 feet*) long, 1.84 meters (*6.04 feet*) wide and just 1.39 meters (*4.56 feet*) high. These proportions emphasize the dynamism of the car's appearance, as do the performance figures for the drive unit. The five-cylinder turbocharged engine has a power output of 300 kW (408 hp). It distributes its power to all four wheels through a seven-speed S tronic transmission and permanent all-wheel drive.
