At the Motorsport Day in Frankfurt/Oder, Audi driver Pierre Kaffer met a **deaf fan**, Eric Schuhr, and spontaneously invited him to the EuroSpeedway – including a pit lane visit and "seat-fitting" in the Audi A4 DTM.
