Second victory for new Audi A4

STCC: Second race, second victory – Team KMS Motorsport can be proud of their results with the new Audi A4 in the Swedish Touring Car Championship (STCC). At Mantorp Park, Audi driver Fredrik Ekblom defended his lead in the championship with a second place in the sprint and a commanding victory in the main race. Tobias Johansson and KMS Team Director Tommy Kristoffersson completed the Audi A4's impressive showing with third and fourth positions. "The A4 is simply perfect and the team came up with a fabulous set-up," enthused Kristoffersson, who fought his way up to fourth place after having started from the back in the main race following his retirement (collision) in the sprint. "I almost overtook the entire field. Our cars were consistently quick over the complete race distance."
