



Biography of Katja Riemann

Katja Riemann, who was born and grew up near Bremen, is one of the best-known German actors. She appeared in the cinema films »Bandits« (1997), »Rosenstrasse« (2003), »A Runaway Horse« (2007) and »Fack ju Göthe« 1 to 3 (2013-2017), among others, and was awarded many prizes for this work, for example the Coppa Volpi, the Deutscher Filmpreis (German Film Award), the Bambi and the Adolf Grimme Prize. For the soundtrack of the film »Bandits«, which she wrote in collaboration with Jasmin Tabatabai and Nicolette Krebitz, she received a Golden Disc award.

Since 2000 she has been a UNICEF ambassador. She supports, among others, Plan International and Amnesty International and works in the interest of an open society. For her commitment to human rights she received the Bundesverdienstkreuz am Band (Order of Merit of the Federal Republic of Germany) in 2010 and the Bad Iburger Courage Prize in 2016. In February 2020 her book "Jeder hat. Niemand darf. Projektreisen" ("Everyone has. No one may. Project Journeys") was published by S.Fischer Verlag.
