

"Our only race in the desert has almost traditionally been the finale of the WEC season. While you're driving, an abrupt stop-and-go rhythm develops - three long straights are followed by very narrow turns. Typical for Bahrain are the high temperatures and lighting conditions during the race. We primarily drive in darkness under floodlights."
