Audi customers continue string of success: In the Australian CAMS NSW Production Sports Car Championship club sport series, the Audi R8 LMS has remained unbeaten this season to date. Following three successes in the opening round at Sydney, the sports car from Germany was again the dominant contender on the second race weekend at Wakefield.
